On December 16, 2010 at 1:55 PM Powell Police received a report of a man being assaulted with a knife in front of the Northwest Trading Post at 410 S Clark St. During the course of the altercation between the victim and Raymond Ortiz, 20, of Lovell; Ortiz allegedly brandished a knife, cutting the victim on the hand and then fled the scene. The victim was treated and released from the Powell Hospital. Officers searched the area for Ortiz and were not able to locate him. During the course of the search several schools in the area were put on lock down as a precautionary measure. This has been referred to the Park County Attorney for charges to be filed and application is being made for a warrant for Ortiz's arrest. Anyone with information regarding Ortiz's location should notify their local law enforcement agency immediately. Ortiz is described as being 5'9" tall, 170 lbs with brown hair and brown eyes.
